*La Leche League Canada is a non-profit organization of volunteer Leaders who since 1961 have been providing breastfeeding support and information to Canadian women, their families and health care professionals. A Board of Directors governs La Leche League Canada and works closely with staff. Our mission is "To encourage, promote and provide mother-to-mother breastfeeding support and educational opportunities as an important contribution to the health of children, families and society." Because our services are provided by volunteers, they are very cost effective. More than 50,000 women contact us each year to receive breastfeeding support at no cost to the already over-burdened health care system.*

### The Cost of Not Breastfeeding:

Riordan, J.M. (1997) The cost of not breastfeeding: a commentary. The Journal of Human Lactation, 13(2), 93-97.

Potential healthcare cost savings from breastfeeding in four medical diagnoses were analyzed. Results showed the following potential savings in healthcare costs: Infant diarrhea, \$630 million; respiratory syncytial virus, \$31 million; insulin-dependant diabetes melitus, \$72 million; and otitis media, \$660 million for a total cost of \$1.3 billion potential savings in healthcare costs using only 4 diagnoses.
