

LLLC In-person Gathering Information

Please note any interaction with the general public poses an elevated risk of being exposed to COVID-19 and we cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed while in attendance at an LLLC meeting. LLLC is committed to following local and provincial (or territorial) guidelines for gatherings. We ask that anyone who does not feel comfortable with the safety guidelines stated by the local and provincial governments and in the LLLC policies that apply to in-person gatherings please refrain from attending an in-person meeting and instead access one of our many virtual options. To respect the privacy of all people in attendance, we will not ask about vaccination status at any point in our meeting. However, we understand that you may have questions about vaccinations as they relate to breastfeeding/human milk. LLLC Leaders are volunteers and not vaccine experts, so we encourage you to check out the resources available from leading public health agencies on our website.

We understand that many attendees at our meetings belong to vulnerable populations. LLLC will abide by provincial/territorial and local public health masking mandates. In the event that masking is no longer required by public health, LLLC remains a guest of this facility/home and as such meeting attendees and Leaders must agree to abide by the masking requests of our meeting location. Regardless of public health guidelines and/or facility requirements, Leaders and/or attendees may continue to wear masks at LLLC meetings if they so choose.

We understand that many people require regular snacks. Parents are permitted to provide food and drinks for their children but are asked to closely monitor its consumption to ensure that food is not shared without permission of the child's parent. We understand that this is difficult but we appreciate your efforts in this.
